

Judge Guy Herman Center for Mental Health Crisis Care: Exclusionary Criteria

The Judge Guy Herman Center for Mental Health Crisis Care provides emergency stabilization for adults experiencing a mental health crisis.

To ensure Integral Care meets the needs of our clients, a licensed clinician will screen each individual prior to admission to the Herman Center. This screening will help determine if the Herman Center offers the appropriate level of care for the individual or if any of the following exclusionary criteria are met.

- Special lines, IVs, medical devices or medical conditions requiring specialized care or supplemental oxygen.
- Any condition requiring medical isolation.
- Requirement for telemetry.
- Medical instability.
- Inability to handle daily living activities, requiring continuous physical assistance and/or requiring regular physical therapy/occupational therapy.
- Physically assaultive or unarousable.
- Pregnancy over 30 weeks.

Clinical exceptions to these exclusionary criteria are made on a case-by-case basis taking a variety of factors into consideration including, but not necessarily limited to, the Herman Center's capacity to provide the appropriate level of care.
